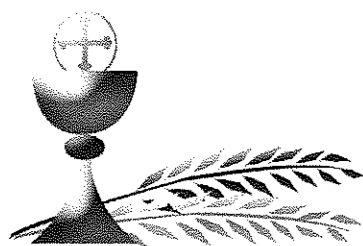


The Church of St. MacNissi

Two months earlier, the Eucharist at the Last Supper is observed on Maundy Thursday.

CEMETERY SUNDAY @ St MacNissi church postponed service until late August when more appropriate mitigations may be in place.

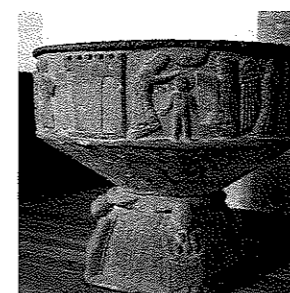
