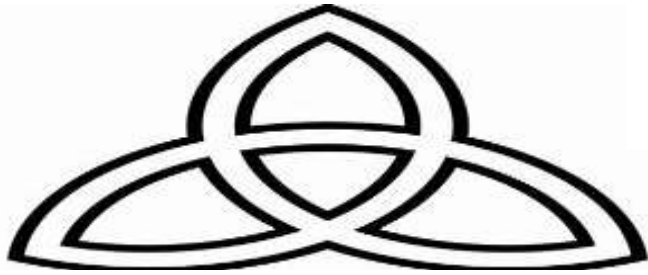

DIOCESAN Covid-19 UPDATE

You will be well aware that in order to restrict the spread of the Virus and in solidarity with civic responsibility Bishop Noel initiated precautions with the intention of preserving life. Much of this addressed social gatherings which impacted on religious services. The medical expertise expressed fears that situations in which a large number of people are gathered closely together, and speaking or singing could be instrumental in spreading the virus. This necessitated actions that none of us had ever experienced with the closing of churches and the restrictions on familiar religious services- with the doors being closed, Mass '*streamed*'!!! and the sacraments postponed – along with requiem Masses, Baptisms, Weddings.

As the threat has lessened there have been some relaxation of these extreme measures.

Funerals with Requiem Mass can now take place **within** a church – but the congregation is restricted to 10 people – socially spaced. So that probably implies immediate family only.

Wedding services may now be celebrated but are currently required to be celebrated in **the open air** in a sacred place – again with only 10 people present - so that would be the couple, two witnesses and five other people – parents?
